### Community Flu Clinics Announced for West Slope of El Dorado County

The El Dorado County Health Services Department, Public Health Division will begin its annual series of low-cost community flu clinics on September 27, with additional clinics offered through the beginning of November. The vaccine to protect against seasonal influenza will be available in both nasal mist and flu shot forms at the flu clinics.

"It is recommended that everyone get vaccinated against the flu annually," said El Dorado County Immunization Coordinator, Cathy Dunbar. "High risk individuals, such as people over age 60, individuals with chronic health conditions, residents of nursing homes, pregnant women, parents of children under six months of age, children six months to four years of age, health care workers and caregivers are especially encouraged to be vaccinated, but anyone who wishes to be protected against the flu should be vaccinated as well."

The cost of the flu vaccine is \$10, but the fee will be waived if an individual cannot pay. Standard Medicare Part B will be billed for people age 65 and older; Medicare HMOs and other insurance cannot be billed. Seniors must bring their Medicare card to the clinic for billing purposes and parents should bring their child's immunization record. The Tdap (whooping cough) booster shot and Pneumonia vaccine will also be available at the clinics for \$10 per shot.

Dates and locations for community flu clinics in the South Lake Tahoe area will be announced soon, according to Dunbar.

People who are severely allergic to eggs or egg products, and infants younger than six months of age should not get the vaccine. Individuals should check with their healthcare provider if they are unsure whether they should receive the flu vaccine. As part of the El Dorado County Health Services' ongoing commitment to the health of our community, we are offering low-cost seasonal flu vaccine to persons 60 year of age and older AND to anyone else who wants to be vaccinated against seasonal influenza.

- **Cost** - There is a \$10 administration fee but we will waive the fee if you cannot pay.
- We will bill standard Medicare Part B for seniors 65 and older. Medicare HMOs and other insurances cannot be billed.
- Both the nasal mist and flu shot will be available at the flu clinics.
- Tdap (whooping cough) booster vaccine and the Pneumonia vaccine will also be available for \$10 per shot.
- Individuals must be six months of age or older to receive flu vaccine.
